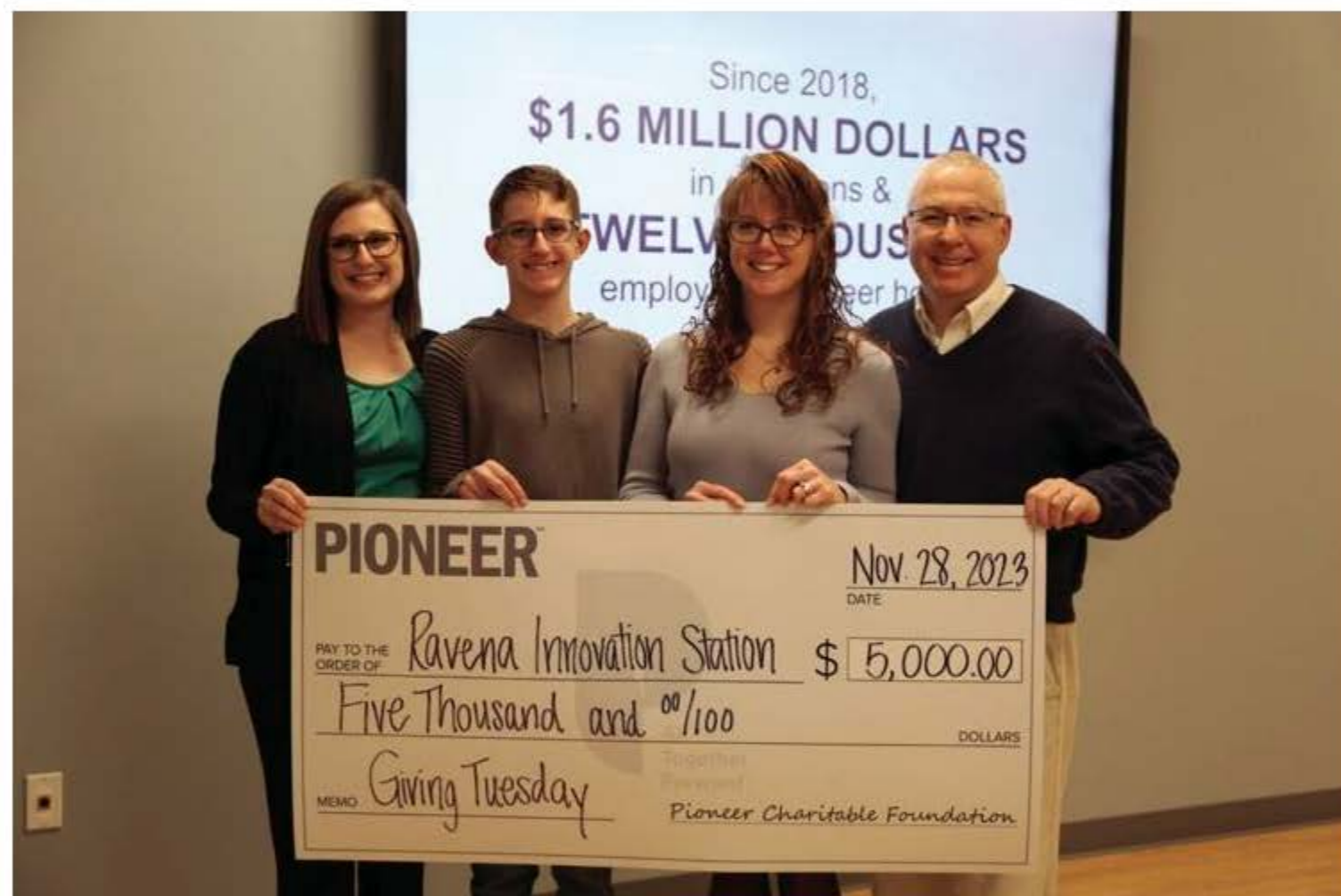


Pioneer marks Giving Tuesday by presenting \$20,000 in donations
